

## **Principal's Message**

As part of the 2023 Principals' Collective Agreement between the Ministry of Education and primary school principals, \$12,000 was allocated for principals' professional development. In Week 8 of this term, I will use this funding to attend a trauma conference overseas and visit schools to meet with principals and psychologists who deal with trauma in young people.

Schools across New Zealand are reporting a surge in students who are struggling to self-regulate and this is a cause of stress for these individual students, teaching staff, other students and families. Trauma informed practice is a strengths-based approach which emphasises physical, psychological and emotional safety for everyone and aims to empower individuals to reestablish control of their lives.

My aim is to explore and learn about this practice and investigate what aspects of the approach could we utilise in a school setting to further support a safe learning environment for all our students. Deputy Principal Ingrid May will be Acting Principal while I am absent from school.




## **Book Week in Year 6**

Sunhill also serves as a park and drop point for the Walking School Bus.


