

Uniform Policy

To ensure compulsory uniform compliance at St Thomas's School.

- 1. The Board of Trustees has the responsibility for setting the uniform code and for making changes as required.
- 2. All students are required to follow the school's uniform dress code.
- 3. The Principal has the authority to sanction, in individual cases, variations from the code for genuine reasons such as medical issues or religious beliefs.
- 4. Students who do not comply with the code, may become subject to the school's disciplinary procedures. Before doing so staff shall consult with the parent or caregiver of a non-complying student to establish whether there is a valid reason for noncompliance.
- 5. In setting the uniform code, or making any significant changes to it, the Board of Trustees has regard for:
 - Equity, practicality, affordability, health and safety, quality, availability
 - Consulting with the school community over any proposed changes to the code
 - Minimising the impact as much as possible through a phase in period
- 6. The Principal is responsible for:
 - Approving individual departures from the code in exceptional circumstances
 - Ensuring compliance with the uniform code by students
 - Making recommendations to the Board of Trustees of where changes to the code may be required.
