Last term several of our Year 5 and 6 students participated in the EPro8 Learning Extension Programme, resulting in a play-off for the top two teams in each year. Working as a team of four, students had to design and build items to specific criteria and achieve certain tasks. Our top Year 5 and 6 teams then competed in the EPro8 Engineering Inter-school Challenge at Churchill Park. Collaboration, mathematical problem solving, and thinking outside the box was the name of the game, all within a tight timeframe. All teams performed very well and can be proud of their accomplishments. Some of their design challenges were to build and motorise a roller coaster, a washing machine which agitated, and a 3 metre air conditioning unit!


